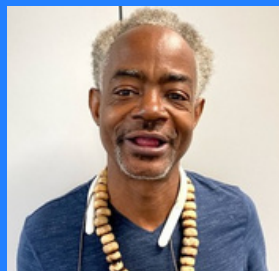

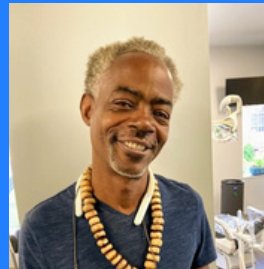

Welcome to Catholic Charities of Southeast Michigan's 2023 Annual Celebration! We are so proud to share this evening with you. You make charity possible in southeast Michigan. Thank you for taking the time to join us this evening and for your generosity and kindness that helps so many people in need throughout our community.

This year, we are excited to share with you the opportunity to help us grow the ministry of Walking With Moms in Need in the Archdiocese of Detroit. Heeding the call of our Archbishop Allen Vigneron, we work to build a culture of life in Catholic parishes so that pregnant and parenting mothers will find a welcoming and supportive community wherever they see a Catholic Church.

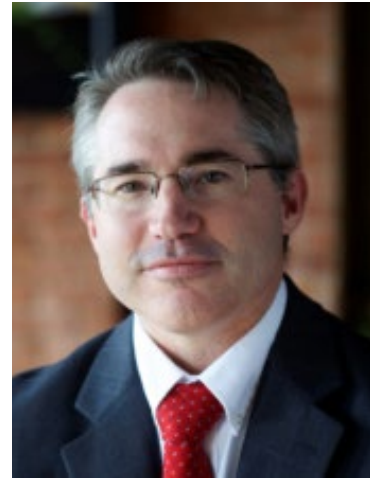

Catholic Charities of Southeast Michigan (CCSEM) is a nonprofit human services organization committed to respecting life and strengthening families. CCSEM annually assists more than 20,000 people through dozens of programs and services regardless of faith, race, culture, or financial wherewithal.

CCSEM formed in 2012 by merging Catholic social services agencies in the region to sharpen mission focus, improve services, and reduce expenses. CCSEM is the Archdiocese of Detroit’s principal agency for works of mercy, providing help with life’s most challenging problems and the hope to overcome them.

CCSEM assists infants, children, teens, adults, pregnant women, couples, families, and seniors, helping all to transform their lives, relationships, and futures. CCSEM champions the dignity of each person and helps improve their quality of life by helping them realize their potential.

CCSEM’s governance board includes members from the six counties served by the agency.

LEONARD R. JAGELS AWARD

Sister Donna Markham, OP, Ph.D.

The Leonard R. Jagels Award honors the memory of former Catholic Social Services Director Leonard Jagels. This award is presented to one outstanding Catholic who is committed to charity in Southeast Michigan and the Archdiocese of Detroit. Through the individual's work he or she put the teachings of the Catholic Church into practice.

Best known for being the first woman to lead Catholic Charities USA as CEO and President from 2015 to 2023, Sister Donna Markham has dedicated her life for more than forty years to reducing poverty and providing care for those at risk. Sister Donna is an Adrian Dominican sister and board-certified clinical psychologist who earned her degree at the University of Detroit. She was awarded the prestigious Harold S. Bernard Training Award from the American Group Psychotherapy Association in February 2014. Over the past several years she has been named by the NonProfit Times as one of the "Power & Influence Top 50 Leaders."

As President and CEO of Catholic Charities USA, Sister Donna Markham led the Healthy Housing effort which provided grants and technical assistance to CCSEM to enable The Residences at St. Matthew in Detroit to become a reality. CCUSA's assistance during the pandemic supported many CCSEM programs, including the creation of the Center for the Works of Mercy in Detroit. CCUSA has also provided AmeriCorps VISTA members to CCSEM. Catholic Charities of Southeast Michigan has grown to serve many more people because of Sister Donna Markham and her direction of CCUSA.



OUTSTANDING PARISH AWARD

St. Irenaeus Catholic Church

The Outstanding Parish Award honors a parish in the Archdiocese of Detroit that is committed to charity in their community. Whether it has been through a project, a hosted program, a collection, or their dedication to a social service, this parish shares Christ's love to help better the lives of those around them.

St. Irenaeus is an active parish in Rochester Hills that is very involved in the community and with CCSEM. Throughout the year various drives and activities are conducted to encourage parishioners to get more involved. In January, they hosted a Life Mass for their Family of Parishes to celebrate life and held a drive for Project Hope. They also provided Adoption and Foster Care and Project Hope with Easter Baskets for all families with children totaling over 160 baskets filled with toys, candy, religious items, and hygiene products. The Refugee Resettlement Program was highlighted during their Lenten mission this year, when they collected household items including pillows, sheets, cleaning products, kitchen items, and hygiene products while also doing special info nights about refugees and how their parishioners could help and increase awareness in the community. The parish team is always open to help Catholic Charities and encourage their parishioners to not just donate money or goods but also learn about our programs and get more involved by volunteering and spreading awareness.



OUTSTANDING ORGANIZATION AWARD

Strangers No Longer

The Outstanding Organization Award honors a Catholic group, school, or organization for their effort in a successful charitable project. With their dedication to helping those in need, they have lived the teachings of Jesus Christ and bettered their community and its members.

Strangers No Longer is a network of Circles of Support formed in Catholic parishes, congregations, and immigrant communities to support our immigrant neighbors and to advocate for a comprehensive and humane immigration policy. Working since 2017, Strangers No Longer has created over 20 Circles of Support in parishes across Southeastern Michigan ranging from Port Huron to Downriver. Seven of the Circles of Support are made up of over 60 immigrant women, who share their experiences and support each other. Additionally, youth from twelve area high schools and parish youth groups have formed a regional committee called Youth in Action for Immigration. They have been integral at La Casa Amiga Legal Clinic as they collaborate to serve the immigrants in southwest Detroit and volunteer to help Afghan refugees. Recently, they have helped set up a remote legal clinic at the Agape Center at St. Clement of Rome parish in Romeo. Strangers No Longer strives to be inclusive and welcoming to those who are new to this country and face immeasurable barriers.

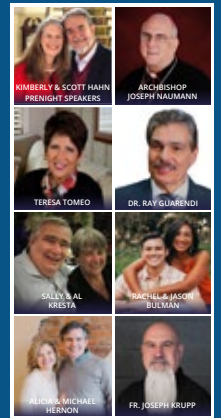

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

ADOPTION, FOSTER CARE, SUPERVISED INDEPENDENT LIVING

Adoption Services facilitate the process for prospective adoptive parents. Staff also helps with searches for birth parents and adoptees. The licensing program helps make what can be a complicated licensing process easier so prospective foster parents can provide warm, safe home environments for children in foster care. The Supervised Independent Living program helps older teens who have “aged out” of the foster care program, assisting these young adults as they transition to independence.

ALL SAINTS SOUP KITCHEN & FOOD PANTRY

The food pantry reopened in June 2022 at its new location in Southwest Detroit, 6945 Wagner in the lower level of the Detroit PAL building on the campus of the former St. Andrew school. The soup kitchen opened earlier this year on Ash Wednesday. With the assistance of dedicated volunteers from area parishes both serve the many young families who call this neighborhood home.

ADULT DAY SERVICES

Offers locations in Macomb and Oakland County providing care during the day for adults with dementia and similar cognitive impairments requiring supervision so caregivers can have respite.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Mental health and substance abuse counseling services for children, teens, adults, couples, and families are provided to help change difficult and destructive behaviors, improve relationships, and promote positive mental, spiritual, physical, and emotional wellbeing.

CENTER FOR THE WORKS OF MERCY

The Center for the Works of Mercy provides comprehensive services rooted in the Corporal Works of Mercy including feeding the hungry, healing the sick, clothing the naked, giving drink to the thirsty, visiting the imprisoned, and sheltering the homeless. Archbishop Vigneron called Catholic Charities to assist in this effort after creating the Unleash the Gospel movement in the Archdiocese of Detroit.

CRISIS INTERVENTION

St. Joseph Center of Hope in Monroe is a crisis intervention center that provides a supervised, supportive setting for individuals with substance use and co-occurring disorders. Individuals can stabilize in a safe and welcoming environment while receiving assistance to enter a treatment program. Open 24 hours a day for individuals 18 years of age and older. No insurance or referral needed.

LA CASA AMIGA LEGAL CLINIC & COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Comprehensive services are provided in Pontiac including immigration legal services, family support programs, and education to immigrants and their families, our friends and neighbors who are new to the United States. Dedicated Catholic Charities staff, empower clients to enrich the community with their diversity, strength, and diligence.

PROJECT HOPE

Project Hope provides support and resources, from conception through birth and beyond, to expectant and parenting mothers. At no cost to the client, they receive supportive counseling, parenting education, referrals to community resources, necessary items for infant care, and more.

REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT PROGRAM

The Refugee Resettlement Program helps families and individuals fleeing persecution in the middle East and other war-torn countries by settling them into permanent housing in metro-Detroit and guiding them on to a path of self-sufficiency as they seek to build safe and hopeful lives for their families.

THE RESIDENCES AT ST MATTHEW (OPENING 2025)

The Residences at St. Matthew on the east side of Detroit will repurpose the St. Matthew School and Activities Building into quality affordable apartments and permanent supportive housing and will address the housing and health needs of many in our community.

SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAMS

AmeriCorps Seniors Foster Grandparents Program, Senior Companion Program, and Retired & Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) provide volunteer opportunities for adults aged 55 and older to serve their communities.

SENIOR OUTREACH PROGRAM

The Senior Outreach Program started in 2020 to meet the needs of seniors isolated due to the COVID-19 pandemic. It since has been established as a permanent program as we determined that vulnerable, isolated seniors are in need regardless of season. The program delivers groceries, including perishables, to eligible clients throughout Macomb, Oakland, and Wayne counties.

WALKING WITH MOMS IN NEED

The Walking with Moms in Need initiative assists parishes in helping mothers link to pregnancy and parenting resources throughout the region and supports moms on their journey and in choosing life.


